Minute No.1 - Before the start of the meeting, President welcomed Group Captain Deepak Ahluwalia as Vice President of the Federation. Thereafter minutes of the last meeting were read out and confirmed.

Minute No.2 - Secretary placed before the members the activity report for the year 2018-19 giving details on the Sub Junior, Junior, Senior Men and Women National Championships held at Bikaner, Dundlod and Nagpur. He also apprised the members that Federation Cup Women was hosted at Dundlod in December 2018 and Federation Cup Men was hosted by the Indian Air Force in Chandigarh in April 2019. Report approved and attached.

Members thanked President Sh. Raghuvendra Singh Dundlod, Secretary Sh. Gajanan Burde and Group Captain Deepak Ahluwalia for hosting the Nationals and Federation Cup Championships. Members specially thanked Group Captain Deepak Ahluwalia for an excellent organization of the event and for his personal presence throughout.

Minute No.3 - Audited Accounts for the year 2018-19 was placed before the members by the Treasurer and the same was duly approved.

Treasurer Sh. Aboobacker proposed the name Jit Verma and Associates Chartered Accountants as an auditor for the year 2019-20. Secretary seconded and the same was approved.

Minute No.4 - President informed the members present that Secretary Kerala State Sports Council called and invited the Federation to discuss and resolve the matter of cycle Polo in Kerala. They also agreed to pay the expenses of traveling of the officials attending the meeting President, Secretary and Assistant Secretary attended the meeting with all relevant documents and files. Meeting was held at the KSSC Office Trivendram and was attended by the President Vice President, Secretary and 3 members of the Kerala State Sports Council and 3 officials of the Federation.

President informed the members that Federation placed all facts with evidence in front of the KSSC officials as well as the list of 32 legal cases which Mr. AM K Nizar and his accomplice files against the Federation, its President and Secretary.

After 2 marathon sessions it was agreed that KSSC will consider all the facts and will work as per the rules and regulations of the Kerala State Sports Council without being biased.

Sh. Aboobacker further informed the members that since the meeting the President of Sports Council has changed and the new President Ms. Mercy Kuttan has in her first press conference announced that KSSC will only entertain those state associations which are duly affiliated to their National Federation.

However he further informed that Cycle Polo Association of Kerala has decided to give legal notice to the Sports Council for contempt as Sports Council has not complied with the ruling of the High Court in regard to recognition of Cycle Polo Association of Kerala.

President and Secretary explained that they are hopeful this long drawn battle will soon be over

The members were glad to hear the efforts of the office bearers and thanked them for the same

Minute No. 10 <u>-</u>. President informed the members present that 12th World Bicycle Polo Championship is scheduled to be held at Buenos Aires, Argentina in December 2019. He was pleased to inform that India has been invited to participate and the same has been confirmed.

Vice President Group Captain Dipak Ahluwalia informed the members that Air Force will conduct the coaching camp either at Chandigarh or Bangalore . He further suggested that it would be best if government guidelines for the coaching camp is followed .

He further announced that he will arrange an amount Rs.100,000/- (Rs. One Lac)for the supplement for the players attending the coaching camp.

He also informed that he will contact Sh. Ajay Singh of Spice Jet for economical airfare of the team.

Members thanked Group Captain Deepak Ahluwalia and unanimously agreed with his suggestion.

Minute No. 11 – In regard to National Calendar Secretary informed the members that one or two State Associations are helping A M K Nizar and other people who are working against the Federation. Due to this he has proposed that till the matter is not finally settled, all National Championships in both sections will be held by the Federation at the venue and date suitable to them. This is important to handle the culprits at the time of championships and avoid any disturbance. Members approved of the same.

Winute No. 12 – The Secretary informed the members of the under mentioned decisions of the Executive Committee:

- a) Umpire examination and Coaches clinic will be held at the time of Senior (Men) Nationals.
- b) President informed the members that letters to Olympic Council of Asia and IOC for encouraging the sport of cycle polo within their jurisdiction.
- c) Sh. P M Abobacker informed the members that under instructions from the President he and Sh. A B Hamsa attended the Kerala Sports Expo 2019 organised by Sports Ministry of Kerala, invitation for which was sent to the Federation.

Minute No. 14

President informed the members that documents in relation to the Registrar of Societies Hyderabad has been completed and submitted to the concerned Department. As for amendment in the Memorandum of Association, President proposed that like many other Sports National Federations a post of CEO should be incorporated in our Federation. He further emphasized that the need for this post has arise due to the Ministry of Sports and Sports Authority of India needing a lot more timely and correct information to be filed to keep the Federation from getting derecognized for not following the National Sports Code. Experience in this regard to the game and its organization will be the key factor for appointment of CEO.

The members approved of the same and asked the Secretary to update the same with The Registrar of Societies.

Minute No.15: Any other matter

The Secretary informed the members about the pending matter of certificate course with Sports Authority of India. Group Capt Dipak Ahluwalia suggested that we should write separately to LNCP Gwalior and Trivendrum for Cycle Polo course. He asked Assarudeen 12 send the Air Force Cycle Polo Syllabus to the Federation.

In regard to School Games National , Group Captain Ahluwalia suggested that to promote the sport amongst youth and students Federation should approach private universities and international schools . This will increase the base of the sport . He further suggested that if required he will send the Air Force team for demonstration of the sport.

Members agreed with the same. President requested the members to send list of private school and university in their respective states.

Group Captain Deepak Ahluwalia suggested the following in regard to the CPL

To check with the CA if separate bank account is required of the Federation for CPL

Duration of 8 days for CPL is too long a period hence reducing the number of cases should be considered and change the match schedule accordingly.

For school children , treasure hunt and or question answer competition may also planned.

Air Force will do its best to organize the Para Jump and Symphony bad disparduring the CPL

Participation of one foreign player during the matched should be made compulsors.

President suggested that exhibition match of Girls Cycle Polo team should also be held and selection from best 3 teams should be done,

Members approved of all above suggestions and gave authority to the President and Secretary to work out everything in the best interest of the sport.

As there was no other matter to be discussed , the meeting concluded with a vote of thanks the Chair.
